- **8 German/6 Russian students** from each partner university
- 2 lecturers from each partner.

<b>March, 25 – 29, 2019:</b>	Workshop, 1 <sup>st</sup> part at Hochschule Niederrhein
April – mid May 2019:	Continuation of work, more detailed analysis and preparation of final presentations.
<b>May 26 – June 2, 2019:</b>	Workshop, 2 <sup>nd</sup> part Ulyanovsk State University (Moscow)

**Credits will only be granted if students participate regularly in the meetings at the home university and in the 2 workshops and in Russian language A1.1 as a block course in March 2019.** Evaluation (marks) will be based on presentations and contributions during workshops and meetings.

Accommodation, breakfast and lunch will be provided by the host institutions. Travelling/visa costs will partly be covered by university/sponsors; about 25% (appr. 250 €) must be covered by each student.
